Trustee Torres: Reminded everyone about the Village Wide Garage Sale coming up on Saturday and Sunday July 30 and 31st. You can still call the Village Hall to have your address put on a sellers list. The list will be on Facebook and available at the Village Hall.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

Public Works Director Joe Lopez: reported that he received a compliment on Steve Davids who did a water meter change in a resident's home and she he said he was very professional and did an excellent job.

Police Chief James Sassetti: Reported that TIP is not monitored 24/7. People are submitting real time information on issues that might need immediate attention. Anything that needs immediate attention should be called in to 911.

Also, there was a significant incident over the weekend of a gun shot victim on the 3900 block of Euclid. The first responding officers that were first on the scene immediately began to render medical aid to the victim. Victim was transported to Loyola hospital where he is in grave condition. The officers were able to identify the offender and take them into custody without incident and recovered the handgun that was used. Thank you to the officers for their hard work and dedication, for Sergeant Ortiz and Detective Ramski who worked tirelessly the entire weekend and were able to charge the offender with major felonies. Thank you to the task force officers from major cases and N. Riverside and Forest View responding officers who helped contain a bad scene. This was a domestic related and isolated incident so there was no threat to the community.
