The Board of Trustees of the Village of Stickney met in regular session on Tuesday, November 16, 2021, at 7:02 p.m. in the Stickney Village Hall, 6533 W. Pershing Road, Stickney, Illinois.

Upon the roll call, the following Trustees were present: Trustees White, Savopoulos, Milenkovic, Torres, Kapolnek and Hrejsa

Trustee Kapolnek moved, duly seconded by Trustee Torres to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting held on Tuesday, November 2, 2021.

Upon the roll call, the following Trustees voted: Ayes: Trustee White, Savopoulos, Milenkovic, Torres, Kapolnek and Hrejsa Absent: None Nays: None Mayor Walik declared the motion carried.

Trustee White moved, duly seconded by Trustee Savopoulos that the bills, approved by the various committees of the Board, be approved for payment, and to approve warrants which authorize the Village Treasurer to draw checks to pay the bills, to be signed by the authorized signers, as provided for by the Ordinances of the Village of Stickney.

Upon the roll call, the following Trustees voted: Ayes: Trustee White, Savopoulos, Milenkovic, Torres, Kapolnek and Hrejsa Absent: None Nays: None Mayor Walik declared the motion carried.

Trustee Milenkovic moved, duly seconded by Trustee Kapolnek, for approval of the Determination of the Amount of Money Estimated as \$2,826,142 to be Necessary to be Raised by Taxation for the Year of 2021 (Collected in 2022) Upon the Taxable Property in the Village of Stickney Pursuant to Section 18-60 of the Truth in Taxation Law.

Upon the roll call, the following Trustees voted: Ayes: Trustee White, Savopoulos, Milenkovic, Torres, Kapolnek and Hrejsa Absent: None Nays: None Mayor Walik declared the motion carried.

Prior to the vote the Mayor introduced David Gonzalez, Stickney's Finance Director. We were directed to the memo for the tentative 2021 tax levy. This is for the taxes collected in 2022. He explained that this the estimate of what we believe that we want to pass in December. We are required to have an estimate done approximately 20 days before its adoption. We will not pass the actual tax levy ordinance until the December board meeting. We will have this on public display starting tomorrow. Per the direction of the Mayor and the Finance Chairman, Jeff White, they requested that we keep the levy at zero from last year. You will see on this attachment that we are estimating the levy to be \$2,826,142. It is the same levy as last year. There is only a slight change in the Police Pension levy. We will need \$42,000 less. We will still be able to fund the Police Pension at the required amount of 100% per the actuarial. We are shifting the \$42,000 to the Corporate Fund. He told us that other than that this is the only change. This tax levy is only an estimate. We could take recommendations until we pass the actual levy in December. He didn't think that there would be that many recommendations considering we are passing a zero levy. He offered to be available to answer questions or concerns.

The Mayor thanked the Finance Chairman and his staff for preparing this levy.

Trustee Savopoulos moved, duly seconded by Trustee White to Pass and Approve Ordinance 2021-22, "An Ordinance Granting and Approving Certain Variances Related to the Construction of Two (2) New Single-Family Homes at the Property Commonly Known as 4429 Wenonah Avenue, Stickney, Illinois"

Upon the roll call, the following Trustees voted: Ayes: Trustee White, Savopoulos, Milenkovic, Torres, Kapolnek and Hrejsa Absent: None Nays: None Mayor Walik declared the motion carried.

The Mayor thanked Village Attorney Tiffany Nelson-Jaworski and the Zoning Board and Trustee Savopoulos for following up on this.

MAYOR'S REPORT: The Mayor showed a toy that looks like the new Gas N Wash Carwash that will be built in Stickney.

<u>CLERK'S REPORT</u>: The Clerk asked for a motion to approve the 2022 Regular Board Meeting Schedule.

Trustee Savopoulos moved, duly seconded by Trustee White to approve the 2022 Regular Board Meeting Schedule.

Upon the roll call, the following Trustees voted: Ayes: Trustee White, Savopoulos, Milenkovic, Torres, Kapolnek and Hrejsa Absent: None Nays: None Mayor Walik declared the motion carried.

The Clerk asked for a motion to approve the 2022 Administrative Office Holiday Schedule.

Trustee Kapolnek moved, duly seconded by Trustee Hrejsa to approve the 2022 Administrative Office Holiday Schedule.

We were reminded about the Toys for Tots collection. On December 11, we will have our senior Christmas Party as well as the party for the kids. Seniors at 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and the kids are 2:00 to 4:00 at the North Clinic. She mentioned a tamale fundraiser at St. Pius Church.

<u>Trustee White:</u> Information was provided for a Stickney-Forest View Lions Club fund raiser. The Village Hall will be closed on Thanksgiving and the day after.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

Fire Chief Jeff Boyajian: Thanksgiving cooking safety information was provided.

<u>Police Chief James Sassetti:</u> The Stickney Police Department will be participating in the IDOT Step Grant next week. We will have additional patrols out there. ORDINANCE NO. 2021-23

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE LEVY AND ASSESSMENT OF TAXES FOR THE VILLAGE OF STICKNEY, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Village of Stickney (the "Village") is a home rule municipal corporation in accordance with Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970; and

WHEREAS, the Village has the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs, and to review, interpret and amend its ordinances, rules and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Village President (the "President") and the Board of Trustees of the Village (the "Village Board" and with the President, the "Corporate Authorities") have determined and do hereby determine that the amounts of money specified herein, exclusive of any cost of conducting an election required by the general election law, are estimated to be necessary to be raised by taxation upon the taxable property in the Village; and

WHEREAS, in connection therewith, the Corporate Authorities previously adopted the annual appropriation ordinance for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2021, and ending April 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is advisable, necessary, and in the best interests of the Village to levy and assess taxes for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2021, and ending April 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the adoption of its tax levy, the Village has complied with Sections 18-60 through 18-85 of the Truth in Taxation Law (35 ILCS 200/18-60 through 35 ILCS 200/18-85), the Open Meetings Act (5 ILCS 120/1, *et seq.*) and all other applicable state and local laws;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF STICKNEY, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL

SECTION 1. INCORPORATION CLAUSE.

The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Ordinance as legislative findings.

SECTION 2. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to approve the levy and assessment of taxes for the Village for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2021 and ending April 30, 2022 and to authorize the President or his designee to take all steps necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance.

ARTICLE II. AUTHORIZATION

SECTION 3. AUTHORITY

This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, the Illinois Property Tax Code and the Village's home rule powers as set forth in the Constitution of the State of Illinois.

SECTION 4. OTHER ACTIONS AUTHORIZED

The officers, employees and/or agents of the Village shall take all action necessary or reasonably required to carry out, give effect to and consummate the legislative action contemplated by this Ordinance and shall take all action necessary in conformity therewith. The officers, employees and/or agents of the Village are specifically authorized and directed to draft and disseminate any and all necessary forms to be utilized in connection with this Ordinance.

ARTICLE III. TAX LEVY

SECTION 5. TOTAL AMOUNT OF APPROPRIATIONS TO BE COLLECTED FROM THE TAX LEVY.

The total amount of appropriations for all corporate purposes legally made to be collected from the tax levy of the current fiscal year is hereby ascertained to be the sum of \$2,826,142.00.

SECTION 6. PURPOSES PROVIDED FOR.

The sum of \$2,826,142.00 being the total of appropriations heretofore legally made that are to be collected from the tax levy of the current fiscal year of the Village for all corporate purposes of the Village, for purposes of providing for a Policemen's Pension Fund and such other corporate purposes as permitted by statute as set forth on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, as appropriated for the current fiscal year, be and the same is hereby levied upon all of the taxable property in the Village subject to taxation for the current year, the specific amounts as levied for the various funds heretofore named being included herein on Exhibit A by being placed in separate columns under the heading "Amount To Be Raised By Tax Levy," which appears over the same, the tax so levied being for the current fiscal year of the Village, and for said appropriation to be collected from said tax levy, the total of which has been ascertained as aforesaid and being as provided in Exhibit A, as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 7. AMOUNT LEVIED

The total amount of \$2,826,142.00 ascertained above, be and is hereby levied and assessed on all property subject to taxation within the Village according to the value of said property as assessed and equalized for state and county purposes for the current year.

SECTION 8. STATE AUTHORITY TO ADOPT ORDINANCE.

This levy Ordinance is adopted pursuant to the procedures set forth in the Illinois Municipal Code and the Illinois Property Tax Code, provided, however, any tax rate limitation or any other substantive limitations as to tax levies set forth in applicable law that are in conflict with this Ordinance shall not be applicable to this Ordinance pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois.

SECTION 9. CERTIFICATION OF LEVY.

There is hereby certified to the Cook County Clerk of Cook County, Illinois, the total amount \$2,826,142.00 which total amount the Village requires to be raised by taxation for the current fiscal year of the Village, and the Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to file with the Cook County Clerk, on or before the time required by law, which is the last Tuesday in December, a certified copy of this Ordinance.

ARTICLE III. HEADINGS, SAVING CLAUSES, PUBLICATION, EFFECTIVE DATE

SECTION 10. HEADINGS.

The headings of the articles, sections, paragraphs and subparagraphs of this Ordinance are inserted solely for the convenience of reference and form no substantive part of this Ordinance nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provision of this Ordinance.

SECTION 11. SEVERABILITY.

The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision of this Ordinance be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable and as though not provided for herein and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect.

SECTION 12. SUPERSEDER.

All code provisions, ordinances, resolutions, rules and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.

SECTION 13. PUBLICATION.

A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form or in a newspaper published and of general circulation within the Village as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.

SECTION 14. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall be effective and in full force immediately upon its passage and approval.
