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The Board of Trustees of the Village of Stickney met in regular session on Tuesday, January 18, 2022, at 7:03 p.m. via Zoom electronic means.

The Mayor announced that the Clerk is still recovering. Deputy Clerk Beth Lukas is covering the duties.

Upon the roll call, the following Trustees were present: Trustees White, Savopoulos, Milenkovic, Torres, Kapolnek and Hrejsa

Trustee Kapolnek moved, duly seconded by Trustee Torres to approve the minutes of the previous regular session on Tuesday, January 4, 2022.

Upon the roll call, the following Trustees voted: Ayes: Trustees Savopoulos, Milenkovic, Torres, Kapolnek and Hrejsa Nays: None Present: Trustee White Mayor Walik declared the motion carried.

Trustee White moved, duly seconded by Trustee Savopoulos that the bills, approved by the various committees of the Board, be approved for payment, and to approve warrants which authorize the Village Treasurer to draw checks to pay the bills, to be signed by the authorized signers, as provided for by the Ordinances of the Village of Stickney.

Trustee Milenkovic moved, duly seconded by Trustee Hrejsa to Pass and Approve Ordinance 2022-01, "An Ordinance Authoring and Approving the Disposal of Personal Property for the Village of Stickney, Cook County, Illinois"

Upon the roll call, the following Trustees voted: Ayes: Trustee White, Savopoulos, Milenkovic, Torres, Kapolnek and Hrejsa Nays: None Mayor Walik declared the motion carried.

Trustee Torres moved, duly seconded by Trustee Hrejsa to Pass and Approve Ordinance 2022-02, "An Ordinance An Ordinance Amending Chapter 2, Article IV, Section 2-313 and Chapter 46, Article II, Section 46-35, and Creating a New Section 46-43 Related to The Lateral Entry Process and Requirements for Certain Police Officers for the Village of Stickney"

Upon the roll call, the following Trustees voted: Ayes: Trustee White, Savopoulos, Milenkovic, Torres, Kapolnek and Hrejsa Nays: None Mayor Walik declared the motion carried.

Trustee Kapolnek moved, duly seconded by Trustee Milenkovic to Approve Resolution 01-2022, "A Resolution Authorizing The Execution of An Intergovernmental Agreement By and Between the Village of Stickney and the Village of Forest View for the Exchange of Municipal Police Vehicles and a Canine"

Upon the roll call, the following Trustees voted: Ayes: Trustee White, Savopoulos, Milenkovic, Torres, Kapolnek and Hrejsa Nays: None Mayor Walik declared the motion carried.

Mayor wank declared the motion carried.

Prior to the vote, Police Chief Sassetti informed us that is an agreement where we are going to be assuming care and control of Ali, Forest View's canine dog, along with their K-9 vehicle for a comparable vehicle. Ali is a four-year-old German Shepard who is currently in training with our K-9 handler. Ali is expected to be placed into duty by the end of February.

Trustee Savopoulos moved, Approve Resolution 02-2022, Trustee White moved to amend the Resolution. The amendment was duly seconded by Trustee Kapolnek.

Village Attorney Tiffany Nelson-Jaworski explained that this is to amend the resolution that is on the website and replace it with a different draft of the Resolution. In addition, she said that this item was on the agenda. In further review of it, we determined that it needed further clarification to make it clear as to what is happening. On September 11, 2020, the Village Board entered into an agreement with U. S. Bank Corp. for financing for certain police vehicles. Since then, the Village Board also approved on June 15, 2021, the purchase of an ambulance. They gave the

Mayor the authority to go up to 4% in the financing of it. Our Finance Director, David Gonzales,, was able to secure a lower finance rate of 1.55%. U.S. Bank Corp. requires that we approve this amendment. You have already approved the purchase of the ambulance. This amendment relates to financing of the purchase of the ambulance.

Trustee White, duly seconded by Trustee Kapolnek to Pass and Approve Resolution 02-2022 as amended.

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-<u>04</u>

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE ACQUISITION OF A CERTAIN VEHICLE FOR THE VILLAGE OF STICKNEY, ILLINOIS.

WHEREAS, the Village of Stickney (the "Village") is a home rule municipal corporation in accordance with Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970; and

WHEREAS, the Village has the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs, and to review, interpret and amend its ordinances, rules and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Village is in need of a vehicle to assist the Village, its employees and its officials in the performance of their duties; and

WHEREAS, the Village has been presented with a purchase agreement (the "Agreement"), attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A, from Jack Phelan Chevrolet to purchase a 2022 Chevy Tahoe (the "Vehicle") with four-wheel drive for forty-two thousand one hundred fifty-five dollars and 24/00 (\$42,155.24); and

WHEREAS, the Village President (the "President") and the Board of Trustees of the Village (the "Board" and with the President, the "Corporate Authorities") deem it advisable and necessary for the operation of the Village to purchase the Vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is necessary, advisable, and in the best interests of the Village and its residents to take all steps necessary to purchase the Vehicle in accordance with the terms of the Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF STICKNEY, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: RECITALS. The facts and statements contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2: PURPOSE. The purpose of this Ordinance is to authorize the purchase of the Vehicle in accordance with the terms of the Agreement, and to authorize the President or his designee to take all necessary steps to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: AUTHORIZATION. The Board hereby authorizes the purchase of the Vehicle in accordance with the terms of the Agreement; waives any bidding requirements related to the purchase of the Vehicle; authorizes and directs the President or his designee to execute any and all necessary documentation to effectuate the same, with such insertions, omissions and changes as shall be approved by the President and the Village Attorney; and ratifies any additional actions taken to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance. The Board further authorizes the President or his designee to execute any and all additional documentation that may be necessary to carry out the intent of this Ordinance. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attest to and countersign any documentation as may be necessary to carry out and effectuate the purpose of this Ordinance. The Village Clerk is also authorized and directed to affix the Seal of the Village to such documentation as is deemed necessary. To the extent that any requirement of bidding would be applicable to the Vehicle described herein, the same is hereby waived.

SECTION 4. HEADINGS. The headings of the articles, sections, paragraphs and subparagraphs of this Ordinance are inserted solely for the convenience of reference and form no substantive part of this Ordinance, nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provision of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision of this Ordinance be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable and as though not provided for herein and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. SUPERSEDER. All code provisions, ordinances, resolutions, rules and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.

SECTION 7. PUBLICATION. A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form or in a newspaper published and of general circulation within the Village as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be effective and in full force immediately upon passage and approval as provided by law.
