Trustee Zeedyk moved, duly seconded by Trustee Walik, to approve the minutes of the previous regular session on Tuesday, July 17, 2012.

President O'Reilly declared the motion carried.**

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: A warm welcome was given to our new Trustee Savopoulos to the board and felt that he would do a good job based on his business background.

TRUSTEES REPORTS:

Trustee Horne welcomed Sam Savopoulos aboard. He has known Sam and his family for a long time. He felt that Sam would be a great asset to this Village and this board.

Trustee Morelli welcomed Sam Savopoulos as well.

Trustee Morelli reported on the July, 2012 Fire Department activity. Calls: There were 157 calls as follows: 4 working fires, 16 service related calls and 88 ambulance calls, 10 automatic fire alarms and trouble alarms, 3 motor vehicle accidents, 20 mutual automatic aid calls, 16 automatic trouble fire alarms, Total calls for 2012 was 753 .

Trustee Savopoulos thanked the Mayor, Trustees and the Village of Stickney for giving him this opportunity. He said he would do the best that he can.

Trustee Walik welcomed Sam. He is a good guy and stated that he knows Sam would do good.

Trustee Walik moved, duly seconded Trustee Horne to accept the treasurer's report for the month of May, 2012.

Trustee Walik informed the people that have alleys who have found promotional flyers taped to their garages, he has discussed the issue with the police. There were a few complaint calls and some people came in. We want to put a stop to it. If there is any damage we will report back to the company and fine them. There are three or four companies doing this. Trustee Walik watched one individual who would hide and start up hanging the flyers when the coast was clear. Trustee Walik is looking into our Ordinances concerning this.

Trustee White welcomed Trustee Savopoulos.

Trustee Zeedyk stated that he has known Sam Savopoulos for many years and consider him a true gentleman.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

Public Works Supervisor Cody Mares updated us on the new recycling bins. The original order of 100 bins is already distributed. There was a second order for 100 placed with a due date of mid October. Public Works Supervisor Cody Mary suggested that people who want one of the bins should pay now and get on the list before that next allocation is gone. A third order might not arrive until December or January.

President O'Reilly informed us that our fire chief is sick and recuperating at home. If you want to send him a card, you can send it to the fire station and he will get it.

There being no further business, Trustee Zeedyk moved, duly seconded by Trustee Walik that the meeting be adjourned. Upon which the Board adopted the motion at 7:24 p.m.

RESOLUTION 09-2012

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF STICKNEY AND FIVE ALARM FIREWORKS

WHEREAS, the Village of Stickney (the "Village") is a home rule municipality in accordance with the Illinois Constitution of 1970;

WHEREAS, the Village of Stickney desires to provide a fireworks exhibition on Sunday, September 2, 2012 in observance of the Labor Day holiday; and

WHEREAS, Fire Alarm Fireworks ("Five Alarm") is willing and able to provide a fireworks exhibition for the Village on Sunday, September 2, 2012, pursuant to the terms of an Agreement between the Village and Fire Alarm (the "Agreement"), which is attached hereto as "Exhibit A"; and

WHEREAS, The Village of Stickney has deemed the terms of the Agreement acceptable:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Stickney, Illinois:

Section 1: The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as the findings of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Stickney, Illinois.

Section 2: The Board of Trustees of the Village of Stickney, Illinois, hereby approve the Agreement for the performance of a fireworks display in the Village on Sunday, September 2, 2012, in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 3: From and after the effective date of this Resolution, the President and Clerk of the Village are hereby authorized and directed to execute the Agreement, and to do all the things necessary and essential, including the execution of any documents and certificates, to carry out the provisions of the Agreement.

General Agreement

This agreement ("Agreement") is made and entered into this day of 20 August 2012 A.D. by and between Five Alarm Fireworks, A Display Company ("Five Alarm"), an Illinois corporation whose principle is to provide firework displays in Illinois and the Village of Stickney.

That for and in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements set forth herein, both parties agree and bind themselves as follows:

1. Five Alarm agrees to provide The Village of Stickney with a professional firework display within The Village of Stickney on September 2, 2012. Five Alarm shall also furnish all equipment to fire the display, on-site safety inspections (to take place prior to the display), firework accountability before and after the display, thorough post-show site clean up, and a second firework display date in the case of inclement weather (i.e. severe thunderstorm and/or winds in excess of 30 mph) to be agreed by *both* mutual parties extended up to one year from the date. Five Alarm shall provide liability and display insurance (as more specifically described in paragraph 2 below). All services and products set forth herein are part of the Agreement price set forth in paragraph 3 below and are at no additional cost to The Village of Stickney.

2. Five Alarm agrees to maintain at its expense at all times during the term of this Agreement, liability insurance and display insurance protecting and indemnifying, The Village of Stickney, its agents, officials and employees, with respect to all claim for personal injuries, death, or property damage incurring on, about, or in connection with the firework display. Such insurance shall name the Village of Stickney, its agents, officials and employees as additional insurers and shall be in an amount not less than \$5,000,000.00 per person and \$5,000,000.00 per accident for injuries or damages to persons and not less than \$5,000,000.00 for damage or destruction of property. Five Alarm shall also maintain workers' compensation insurance and be required to cover its employees working on or about the festival grounds.

3. That in consideration for the above mentioned the Village of Stickney shall pay Five Alarm Fireworks Co. Six Thousand Dollars .00/100 (\$6,000.00) on or before September 2, 2012.

4. The Village of Stickney agrees to furnish police protection and fire protection at the festival grounds where the fireworks display will be held at no cost to Five Alarm Fireworks Co.

5. That it is mutually agreed by both parties hereto that there is no other contract or promise, either written or verbal existing between them which is not referenced herein.

6. Five Alarm shall protect, indemnify and save the Village of Stickney, its employees, agents and officials harmless from and against any and all loss, liability, cost or expense of any kind related to or arising from injury or damage to persons or property arising out of the fireworks display provided by Five Alarm.

7. Five Alarm shall apply for all license and permits required by the City and State law for the display of fireworks they will provide under this Agreement, and shall pay all applicable taxes and/or license fees imposed by the same.

8. Five Alarm agrees to comply with all applicable rules, regulations, ordinances, and laws of the Village of Stickney and of the State of Illinois, and to cooperate with the Fire Marshall or his designee with regard to the movement of motor vehicular and pedestrian traffic in and out of the festival grounds.

9. This Agreement shall be interpreted by and governed by the laws of the State of Illinois and parties agree that any lawsuits arising out this Agreement must be filed in the Circuit Court of Cook County.

10. This Agreement may be notified only in writing signed by all parties hereto.

11. All parties executing this Agreement represent and warrant that they have full authority to enter into and execute this Agreement on behalf of the entity for whom they are purportedly acting. This Agreement is signed by an authorized representative of the Village of Stickney in that representative's official capacity only and the representative shall have no personal liability under this Agreement.

12. Five Alarm assumes full responsibility for the payment of all federal, state, and local taxes incurred by Five Alarm as a result of this agreement.

13. Five Alarm, pursuant to 720 ILCS 5/33E-1 I as amended, hereby certifies that neither it nor any of its partners, officers or owners has been convicted in the past five years of the offense of bid rigging under 720 ILCS 5/33E-3 as amended; that neither it nor any of its partners, officers, or owners has ever been convicted of the offense of bid rotating under Section 720 ILCS 5/33E-4 as amended and that neither it nor any of its partners, officers, or owners has ever been convicted of bribing or attempting to bribe an officer or employee of the State of Illinois or has made an admission of guilt of such conduct which is a matter of record.

14. Five Alarm shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, ancestry, age, marital status, physical or mental handicap, an unfavorable discharge from military service, or any other factor as prohibited by law in the hiring, employment, promotion, or training of personnel. Five Alarm certifies that it is an equal opportunity employer.

15. Five Alarm certifies that it maintains a written sexual harassment policy in conformance with 775 ILCS 5/2 - 105.

16. If Five Alarm has more than 25 employees, Five Alarm certifies that it provides a Drug Free Workplace in compliance with the Drug Free Workplace Act. 30 ILCS 580/1 et seq.

17. Time is of the essence of this Agreement.
