Upon the roll call, the following Trustees were present: Trustees Hrejsa, Kapolnek, Milenkovic, Savopoulos, Torres and White

Trustee Milenkovic moved, duly seconded by Trustee Kapolnek to approve the minutes of the previous regular session on Tuesday, August 21, 2018.

Upon the roll call, the following Trustees voted: Ayes: Trustee Hrejsa, Kapolnek, Milenkovic, Savopoulos, Torres and White Absent: None Nays: None Mayor Walik declared the motion carried.

Trustee White moved, duly seconded by Trustee Savopoulos that the bills, approved by the various committees of the Board, be approved for payment, and to approve warrants which authorize the Village Treasurer to draw checks to pay the bills, to be signed by the authorized signers, as provided for by the Ordinances of the Village of Stickney.

The Mayor explained that this was a matter that appeared before the Zoning Board hearing.

Trustee White moved, duly seconded by Trustee Hrejsa to pass and approve Ordinance 2018-41, "An Ordinance Authorizing and Approving the Disposal of Obsolete Personal Property for the Village of Stickney, Illinois"

Prior to the vote Trustee White explained that we have to do this in order to sell the obsolete garbage trucks.

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Trustee Savopoulos moved, duly seconded by Trustee Milenkovic to approve Resolution 22-2018, "A Resolution Regarding the Release of Executive Session Minutes"

Upon the roll call, the following Trustees voted: Ayes: Trustee Hrejsa, Kapolnek, Milenkovic, Savopoulos, Torres and White Absent: None Nays: None Mayor Walik declared the motion carried.

Trustee White moved, duly seconded by Trustee Savopoulos to Approve Resolution 23-2018, "A Resolution in Support of, and Authorizing an Application for the Energy Efficiency Program from ComEd for the Village of Stickney, County of Cook, State of Illinois:

Upon the roll call, the following Trustees voted: Ayes: Trustee Hrejsa, Kapolnek, Milenkovic, Savopoulos, Torres and White Absent: None Nays: None Mayor Walik declared the motion carried.

The clerk explained the following about this item on the agenda: Item 10: There was a scrivener error in the title of Resolution 23-2018. The title should have read, "A Resolution Authorizing and Approving an Agreement with H & H Electric for the LED Lighting Project, for the Village of Stickney, County of Cook, State of Illinois"

Prior to the vote the Mayor explained that this is for H & H Lighting to put in LED lighting on Ridgeland Avenue, Oak Park Avenue and 43rd Street. It was put out to bid. The cost is \$24,519.60. That is with discounts. It should be paid off in 1.5 years.

<u>MAYOR'S REPORT</u>: Once again he spoke about the LED lighting. Our whole town will be LED lighting for our streets and alleys except for our parks. In the near future, Public Works will be patching holes in the municipal parking lot on Pershing. It then will be seal coated and striped. The Mayor invited people to take a look at our visitor center. Trustee Milenkovic reorganized the visitor center. He did an amazing job. It contains memorabilia from the village. The Mayor thanked all the Trustees for Family Day, all the volunteers, all our Parks and Recreation committee, our Police and Public Works. The food was great. The weather was great. The fireworks were spectacular. He also thanks Village Attorney Mike Del Galdo for his donation to the fireworks.

<u>TRUSTEE REPORTS</u>: Trustee Savopoulos reported that the sidewalk replacements will start soon. Andreas, the cement contractor, will go out to measure the sidewalks to give us a square footage.

<u>Trustee Milenkovic</u> notified us that they will be planting about a dozen trees in mid-October.

The Mayor thanked Trustee Torres for all her work at Family Day.

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<u>Trustee Kapolnek</u> thanked all the sponsors for the fireworks because they were great. And, a big thank you to the Mayor for putting on another great Family Day.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

<u>Police Chief Babich</u> spoke about street sweeping. They receive calls questioning why they are not ticketing for street sweeping. They go through one time. Sometimes people leave and come back. We can't keep track of over 500 vehicles even though they have been entered into the computer. They have to keep it (the vehicle) out of there. They may have just come home at 3:00 in the afternoon. We try to be reasonable with our residents. We try to make everybody happy. They are being enforced. The officer is out there by 8:00 ticketing the whole town. It takes about 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours. Then we let the street sweeper do its job. We have to keep writing tickets even if the street sweeper is down. We have to keep writing. We need to keep people trained that day is the day. If we back off then people keep parking on the other side. In addition, the police will continue to monitor Edison School for a training operation for the parents to learn where to drop off students. They need to learn that they can't drop off where the red cones are. The Police Chief then addressed the request to tour the Cicero 911 Center. We will have a single date available shortly. There will be two time slots available. It will be 11:00 a.m. or 7:00 p.m.

The Mayor asked that the Police Department put out a Code Red next Sunday to remind people that the sweeper is back in service. He noticed that there were cars parked today.

<u>Public Works Director Joe Lopez</u> announced that we have the sweeper back in service. There had been fire inside it. Garbage will be behind one day due to Labor Day.

<u>Fire Chief Jeff Boyajian</u> notified us that they received a call today of a house fire. When they responded they found a young man out front holding his dog. The young man told them that his kitchen was on fire. Apparently there was a pot of boiling oil on the stove that caught on fire. The young man put a lid on the pot. What he didn't realize was the act of placing a lid on the pot actually put out the flames. Baking soda or salt can put out a cooking fire. Never use flour. A wet towel could be used. If you have a fire in the oven, keep the oven door closed until the fire department arrives.

There being no further business, Trustee White moved, duly seconded by Trustee Milenkovic that the meeting be adjourned. Upon which the Board adopted the motion at 7:22 p.m.

RESOLUTION NO. 24 -2018

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH H & H ELECTRIC COMPANY FOR THE COMED ENERGY EFFICIENT PROGRAM FOR THE VILLAGE OF STICKNEY, COUNTY OF COOK, STATE OF ILLINOIS AND RATIFYING THE ACTION TAKEN ON SEPTEMBER 4, 2018.

WHEREAS, the Village of Stickney (the "Village") is a home rule municipal corporation in accordance with Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970; and

WHEREAS, the Village has the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs, and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, Commonwealth Edison ("ComEd") administers the Energy Efficiency Program (the "Program"), which grants rebates to communities based on the reduction of energy consumed for lighting and other electrical power uses (the "Grant"); and

WHEREAS, the Village President (the "President") and the Board of Trustees of the Village (the "Village Board" and with the President, the "Corporate Authorities"), being committed to reducing the Village's energy usage and energy related costs, previously applied for and was awarded the Grant; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with the Grant, the Village desires to engage the services of a contractor to replace the existing street light luminaires with new LED street light luminaires to achieve these goals (the "Services"); and

WHEREAS, after competitive bidding, the Village Engineer determined that H & H Electric Co. ("H & H") was the lowest bidder and recommended that the contract be awarded to H & H; and

WHEREAS, H & H has provided a Local Public Agency Formal Contract, a form contract provided by the Illinois Department of Transportation, (the "Contract"), attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A, which generally sets forth the terms, covenants and conditions under which H & H will provide the Services to the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is necessary, advisable and in the best interests of the Village and its residents to enter into and approve contracts with substantially the same terms as the terms of the Contract; and

WHEREAS, this matter first appeared on the agenda, was included in the "Board Packet" posted on the Village's website and was approved on September 4, 2018, yet as a result of a scrivener's error in the title of the legislation and on the agenda for the September 4, 2018 meeting, the Village Board wishes to ratify that action by approving this Contract again at the September 18, 2018 meeting; and

WHEREAS, the President is authorized to enter into and the Village Attorney (the "Attorney") is authorized to revise contracts for the Village making such insertions, omissions and changes as shall be approved by the President and the Attorney;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF STICKNEY, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: RECITALS. The facts and statements contained in the preamble to this Resolution are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this Resolution.

SECTION 2: PURPOSE. The purpose of this Resolution is to authorize the President or his designee to enter into the Contract whereby H & H will provide the Services to the Village, to authorize the President and the Attorney to make such insertions, omissions and changes as necessary, and to further authorize the President or his designee to take all steps necessary to carry out the terms and intent of this Resolution and to ratify any steps previously taken to effectuate those goals, including but not limited to ratifying the action taken to approve this Contract on September 4, 2018.

SECTION 3: AUTHORIZATION. The Board hereby authorizes and directs the President or his designee to authorize, enter into and approve the Contract in accordance with its terms, or any modifications thereof, and to ratify any and all previous action taken to effectuate the intent of this Contract, including but not limited to ratifying the action take to approve this Contract on September 4, 2018. The Board further authorizes and directs the President or his designee to execute the Contract with such insertions, omissions and changes as shall be approved by the President and the Attorney. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attest to and countersign the Contract and any other documentation as may be necessary to carry out and effectuate the purpose of this Resolution. The Village Clerk is also authorized and directed to affix the Seal of the Village to such documentation as is deemed necessary. The officers, agents and/or employees of the Village shall take all action necessary or reasonably required by the Village to carry out, give effect to and consummate the purpose of this Resolution and shall take all action necessary in conformity therewith. To the extent that any requirement of bidding would be applicable to the Services, the same is hereby waived.

SECTION 4: HEADINGS. The headings of the articles, sections, paragraphs and subparagraphs of this Resolution are inserted solely for the convenience of reference and form no substantive part of this Resolution nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provision of this Resolution.

SECTION 5: SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this Resolution are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision of this Resolution be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable and as though not provided for herein and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect.

SECTION 6: SUPERSEDER. All code provisions, ordinances, resolutions, rules and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.

SECTION 7: PUBLICATION. A full, true and complete copy of this Resolution shall be published in pamphlet form or in a newspaper published and of general circulation within the Village as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.

SECTION 8: EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall be effective and in full force immediately upon passage and approval as provided by law.

wireless equipment, appliances and systems used for the transmission and reception of signals of any nature, business, domestic, commercial, education, entertainment, and residential purposes, including but not limited to, communicationand telephone, electronic and sound equipment, fiber optic and data communication systems, and the performance of any task directly related to such installation or service whether at new or existing sites, such tasks to include the placing of wire and cable and electrical power conduit or other raceway work within the equipment room and pulling wire and/or cable through conduit and the installation of any incidental conduit, such that the employees covered hereby can complete any job in full.
