The Board of Trustees of the Village of Stickney met in regular session on Tuesday, July 5, 2016 at 7:02 p.m. in the Stickney Village Hall, 6533 W. Pershing Road, Stickney, Illinois.

Upon the roll call, the following Trustees were present: Trustees Fuentes, Hrejsa, Lazansky, Milenkovic and Savopoulos Absent: Trustee White

Trustee Lazansky moved, duly seconded by Trustee Savopoulos, to approve the minutes of the previous regular session meeting held on June 21, 2016 as submitted by the clerk.

Upon the roll call, the following Trustees voted:

Trustee Lazansky moved, duly seconded by Trustee Savopoulos, to approve the payment of the bills.

Trustee Lazansky moved, duly seconded by Trustee Fuentes, to pass and approve Ordinance 2016-16, "An Ordinance Authorizing the Village President to Enter into a Certain Agreement with Sokol Stickney for the Village of Stickney

Prior to the vote Trustee Hrejsa asked, "Is this to go till August 31?" "He (Rich Vachata) had stated that he needed a meeting with his group." Mayor Morelli said that he came in to sign.

PRESIDENT REPORT: None

CLERKS' REPORT: None

TRUSTEES' REPORTS: Trustee Fuentes gave the fire department report for the month of June, 2016 as follows: Ambulance calls: 75; Mutual Aid Calls: 8; Service Calls: 6; Fire Calls: 12; Hazardous Condition Calls: 1; Motor Vehicle Accidents: 10; Working Fires: 0; Brush/Trash Fire Calls: 0; Car Fires: 1; Outside Equipment Fires: 0; Total calls for the month of June: 113; Total calls for 2016: 549.

In addition, Trustee Fuentes announced that on last Saturday we had an indoor/outdoor flea market at the Recreation Center. Since it was 90 degrees there were no takers for the outdoor tables. There were 13 seller tables. The Village sold hot dogs, chips and drinks. They roughly made a profit of \$315.00 on the event. The next Parks and Rec meeting will be on July 18, 2016 at 6:30 p.m. in the village hall. There is a back-to-school clean up in the works that is currently scheduled. The 3rd Annual Fall Fest will be on September 10, 2016.

Trustee Milenkovic reported there would be a meeting of the Tree Board Advisory Committee on July 7, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. in the Conference Room.

Trustee Savopoulos informed us that IDOT will suspend all IDOT contracts as of June 30, due to the budget stalemate. It will cost 25,000 construction workers being laid off.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS: Deputy Police Chief Jaczak told us, "It was a busy stretch for the police department." "On the morning of July 1, they started issuing our Village sticker tickets." "They wrote 192 tickets." "They have to be displayed." "They cannot be voided out." "They have to go to court." "We received two calls last night for fireworks." "There were a lot more fireworks going on." "They gave a dozen warnings." "Any house they went back to received a ticket." "Two Sundays ago, one of our patrolmen discovered a deceased body in an alleyway." "A murder investigation was started." "Within two hours we had 15 detectives in town." "We used the Sokol Hall as our initial command center where it was air conditioned." "We then moved back here." "It is still under investigation so I cannot give you details." "It is not a murder investigation anymore." "It is a death investigation." "That is significant because there was no murder in town." "There were rumors of being raped and choked." "That was not the case." "There was no murder." "There was no sex assault." "There was no assault at all." "It is still an open investigation and no longer a murder investigation." "Detectives Cruz Ortiz and Kevin McGuire are handling the investigation." In addition, the Deputy warned, "Delivery notice stickers are being placed on a few doors in town." "Unless you make an appointment with someone, they should not come to your door." "If someone comes to your door, even if they are wearing a public works uniform, call 911." "If something doesn't feel right, it probably isn't." "Make the call so we can check them out." "We will know after the fact if they are legitimate." "They could be ticketed or arrested." The clerk asked about the notice sticker. "It looks generic and somewhat like a UPS notice."

Public Works Supervisor Jeff Boyajian mentioned, "Sam, since you read that IDOT notice, the stop gap budget will allow all projects to continue to the end of the year." Street sweeping will be suspended this week due to Public Works employees taking vacation. Pick-ups will be delayed one day because of the short week.

Fire Chief Larry Meyer reported on a house fire yesterday afternoon. It was not due to fireworks. The neighbors saw smoke. When a house fire starts to burn the smoke is very light colored. When the fire department got in they found the upstairs very hot. The source was electrical in nature. The house used to be a store and it was covered in brick veneer. They ran BX wiring in there. Two dogs got out. The guys did a great job.

Treasurer Kurt Kasnicka informed us that on Tuesday, July 19, 2016 at 6:30 p.m. we will have a public hearing for the purpose of presenting the annual budget and appropriation ordinance for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2016 and ending April 30, 2017. This will be at 6:30 p.m. and the regular meeting will be at 7:00 p.m. A copy of the proposed budget is available for inspection. It is posted on the bulletin board. If you would like a copy of it, you can fill out a Freedom of Information Act request and you will be given a copy right away.

Trustee Lazansky moved, duly seconded by Trustee Milenkovic to adjourn into executive session at 7:15 p.m.

RESOLUTION NO. <u>10</u>-2016

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT TO ENTER INTO A PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING SERVICES AGREEMENT REGARDING THE RESURFACING OR REHABILITATION OF CERTAIN STREETS WITH FRANK NOVOTNY AND ASSOCIATES, INC. FOR THE VILLAGE OF STICKNEY

WHEREAS, the Village of Stickney (the "Village") is a home rule municipal corporation in accordance with Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970; and

WHEREAS, the Village has the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs, and to review, interpret and amend its ordinances, rules and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Village President (the "President") and the Board of Trustees of the Village (the "Village Board" and with the President, the "Corporate Authorities") are committed to ensuring the safety of individuals walking and driving within the corporate limits of the Village; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the foregoing, the Village has determined that it is in the best interests of the Village and its residents to make certain resurfacing and rehabilitation improvements to certain sections of East Avenue within the Village (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Project includes, without limitation, hot-mix asphalt surface removal, spot location curb and gutter removal and replacement, frame and grate adjustments, hot-mix asphalt leveling binder and surface course paving, pavement markings and parkway restoration and an appurtenant construction; and

WHEREAS, the Village recognizes the need for a third party to provide certain professional engineering services to the Village in connection with the Project (the "Services"); and

WHEREAS, Motor Fuel Tax funds will be used entirely or in part to finance the Project; and

WHEREAS, Frank Novotny and Associates, Inc. ("Novotny") has provided the Corporate Authorities with an agreement (the "Agreement"), attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A, which sets forth such terms, covenants and conditions under which Novotny will provide the Services to the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find that it is necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the Village to approve, enter into and execute an agreement with terms substantially the same as the terms of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the President is authorized to enter into and the Village Attorney (the "Attorney") is authorized to revise agreements for the Village making such insertions, omissions and changes as shall be approved by the President and the Attorney;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF STICKNEY, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: RECITALS. The facts and statements contained in the preamble to this Resolution are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this Resolution.

SECTION 2: PURPOSE. The purpose of this Resolution is to authorize the President or his or her designee to enter into the Agreement whereby Novotny will provide the Services to the Village and to further authorize the President or his or her designee to take all steps necessary to carry out the terms and intent of this Resolution and to ratify any steps taken to effectuate those goals.

SECTION 3: AUTHORIZATION. The Board hereby authorizes and directs the President or his or her designee to authorize, enter into and approve the Agreement in accordance with its terms, or any modifications thereof, and to ratify any and all previous action taken to effectuate the intent of this Resolution. The Board further authorizes and directs the President or his or her designee to execute the Agreement with such insertions, omissions and changes as shall be approved by the President and the Attorney. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attest to and countersign the Agreement and any other documentation as may be necessary to carry out and effectuate the purpose of this Resolution. The Village Clerk is also authorized and directed to affix the Seal of the Village to such documentation as is deemed necessary. The officers, agents and/or employees of the Village shall take all action necessary or reasonably required by the Village to carry out, give effect to and consummate the purpose of this Resolution and shall take all action necessary in conformity therewith. To the extent that any requirement of bidding would be applicable, the same is hereby waived.

SECTION 4. HEADINGS. The headings of the articles, sections, paragraphs and subparagraphs of this Resolution are inserted solely for the convenience of reference and form no substantive part of this Resolution nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provision of this Resolution.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this Resolution are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision of this Resolution be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable and as though not provided for herein and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. SUPERSEDER. All code provisions, ordinances, resolutions, rules and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.

SECTION 7. PUBLICATION. A full, true and complete copy of this Resolution shall be published in pamphlet form or in a newspaper published and of general circulation within the Village as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall be effective and in full force immediately upon passage and approval as provided by law.
