RESOLUTION # 06 – 2011

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT FOR THE ACQUISITION OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY LOCATED AT 4131 SOUTH HOME AVENUE, STICKNEY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Village of Stickney (the "Village") is a home rule municipality in accordance with the Illinois Constitution of 1970;

WHEREAS, pursuant to its home rule powers and the powers set forth in the Illinois Municipal Code 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1 *et seq.*, the Village has the authority to acquire real property in the exercise of the Village's powers;

WHEREAS, the Village desires to provide a meeting place to serve the best interest of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of the above stated goals, the Village has determined that it is in the best interest and the common good of the Village's residents that it acquire certain real property located at 4131 S. Home Ave., Stickney, Illinois for the purchase price of <u>ten</u> dollars (\$10.00); and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Trustees considered the acquisition and acceptable costs to be incurred as a result of the acquisition at the Board Meeting on July 22, 2011 and agreed upon acceptable terms and conditions of said acquisition.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Stickney, Illinois:

Section 1: The Board of Trustees of the Village of Stickney authorizes and approves the acquisition of the real property located at 4131 S. Home Ave., Stickney Illinois, for the purchase price of <u>ten</u> dollars (\$10.00).

Section 2: Said acquisition is subject to and conditioned upon approval of Village counsel of any issues related to title and taxation agreements related thereto.

Section 3: Said acquisition is further subject to and conditioned upon successful completion of all necessary inspections to confirm the sound, safe and hazard-free condition of the premises or the provision of the appropriate credits against the purchase price in the event that remediation or corrections to the property are necessary.

Section 4: The Board of Trustees of the Village of Stickney hereby authorizes and directs the President of the Village, in his official capacity, to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the completion of the acquisition of said real property.

Section 5: This Resolution shall remain in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6, "ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR," OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF STICKNEY, ILLINOIS BY AMENDING ARTICLE III. ENTERTAINMENT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF STICKNEY, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, A HOME RULE UNIT OF GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the Village of Stickney (the "Village") is a home rule municipality in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Stickney desires to regulate entertainment at establishments that serve alcoholic liquor; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Stickney has deemed it necessary to establish a licensing procedure for, and to regulate certain forms of entertainment within establishments licensed to serve alcoholic liquor within the Village; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEE OF THE VILLAGE OF STICKNEY, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

Section 1. Recitals. The facts and statements contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this Ordinance.

Section 2. Adoption. Chapter 6, Article III. ENTERTAINMENT, Section 6-100. Definition of Entertainment of the Municipal Code of the Village of Stickney shall be amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE III. ENTERTAINMENT

Sec. 6-100. Definition of Entertainment.

The term "Entertainment," as used in this Article shall mean: any exhibition, performance, presentation for show, or hosting, for entertainment purposes, of any live music or music played by a disc jockey or emcee, or of any dancing event involving public participation; any live performance of any nature meant for entertainment; any dancing, talent, or skill exhibition or competition or contest; any karaoke performance, or fashion show; and any other entertainment or recreational activity that is offered for public participation, whether or not an admission fee, "cover charge" or other remuneration is required from the spectators and/or participants. The term "Entertainment" shall not apply to any event occurring on premises that is licensed by the State of Illinois to operate a racetrack for horse racing purposes in the state.

Section 3. Home Rule. This ordinance is enacted under the Home Rule powers of the Village as set forth in the Constitution and laws of the State of Illinois.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.

Section 5. Conflicts. This Ordinance supersedes all ordinances or parts of ordinances directly conflicting with the terms and provisions contained herein, but only to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

Section 7. Certification and Publication. The Village Clerk of the Village of Stickney shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and cause the same to be published in pamphlet form.

This letter is to certify that Central Blacktop Company, Inc. has furnished labor and materials, for the above-captioned project, in accordance with the attached "Engineer's Payment Estimate No. 1."

As of July 19th, the Contractor has completed the following percentages of categorized work on this project at the street locations shown on the attached map:

The Contractor has completed all contract work except for the placement of the parkway sod which is currently on hold due to the extremely hot weather. The Contractor is currently on schedule to complete the project in the allowable number of working days as specified by the contract.

The construction and engineering cost for this project will be funded by a combination of Illinois DCEO Grant funds (\$500,000) and the balance by Motor Fuel Tax (MFT) funds (\$40,000 +/-).

Therefore, we authorize the payment of \$323,623.35 to Central Blacktop Company, Inc., P.O. Box 2080, LaGrange, IL 60525, to be paid in accordance with the terms of their Contract. Also enclosed is a copy of the "Waiver of Lien" for the payment amount.
