TRUSTEE REPORTS: Trustee Mares reminded us of the recreation event opportunities available through Central Stickney Park District. Our music in the park is going strong.

Trustee Morelli reported that she has had a recent meeting with the advisory committee overseeing the July 16, Craft/Flea Market event. A basic line- up is in place. Flyers are available. It will be at 41st and Ridgeland. Bring your own table for your 8 foot x 8 foot section. There is a \$20 fee. The flyer has contact information. Information can also be found on facebook. Trustee Mares said that a few tables could be supplied.

Trustee Schimel reaffirmed his previous report on the Cook County long-term-homeowners exemption. The final date to apply for this is June 22. Go see Ken at the Assessor's Office located in the basement of the Clinic building and get it straighten out.

Trustee Walik reported on the trees. He explained that he submitted an article for the next newsletter that asks residents to give him a call if they know of any tree in the parkway that needs trimming.

Trustee Zeedyk updated us on the status of the street improvements. It is all going fairly well. Lorraine Terrace had the one complaint which has been rectified.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS: Jeff Boyajian reported on behalf of the Fire Department. The aerial ladder and the ground ladders have been tested and found in compliance. He reminded us about the July $4^{\rm th}$ fireworks law and safety precautions. The police will arrest those who are misusing fireworks.

Police Chief Joe Kretch informed us that the police recently went through rapidresponse training at Edison School at the beginning of the month. He explained that this training is a simulation of an offender entering a school or a business and may be threatening lives. The officers are trained to go after the hypothetical individuals and take them into custody. A couple of the officers remarked that they enjoyed the training and would like to go through it again.

Public Works Supervisor Joe Lopez reminded us that public works will be off on Monday, July 4 and will cause their schedule to be pushed back one day. His department received calls concerning flooding on a couple of blocks. It was found that the sewers were blocked with tree roots and debris. He asked that people phone in reports of this condition.

Treasurer Kurt Kasnicka informed us that vehicle sticker sales continue for nine more days. He provided the extended office hours and Saturday hours. There is a notice on the front door informing people of the hours. The office will be closed on July 4.
